



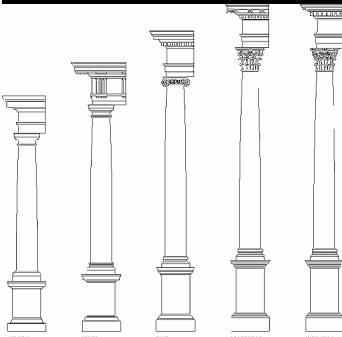
Niagara Society of Architects Bursary

Board coordinators circulate the application forms to the Schools.

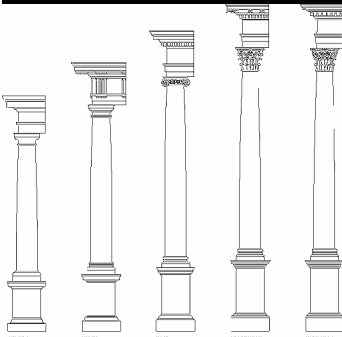
One submission is made from each school to the Boards' Coordinators who forward them to the Niagara Society of Architects.

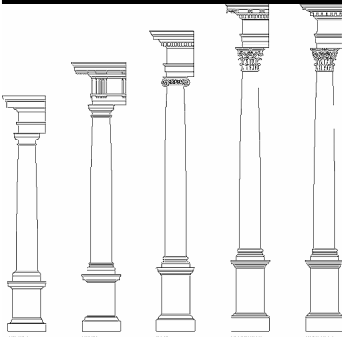

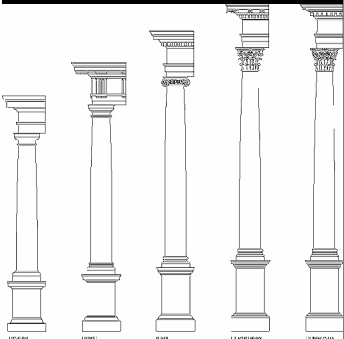
